

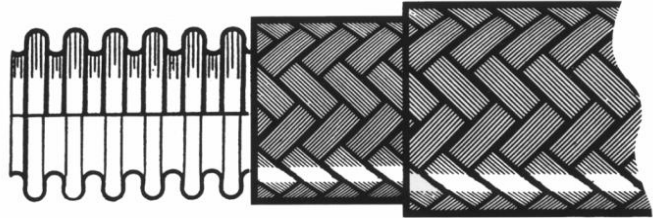

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WORKING PRESSURE

Working pressures are quoted for fluid temperatures at 20°C. Higher fluid temperatures will result in a lower working pressure. These modified working pressures can be calculated using the TEMPERATURE CORRECTION CHART on page 13 of the Artiflex Catalogue.

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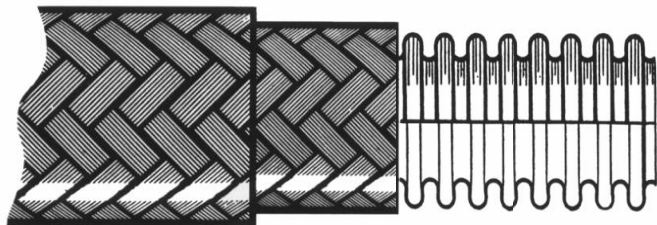
TEST PRESSURE

To avoid distortion of the convoluted form of the hose, the maximum test pressures quoted in this literature **must not be exceeded**. All hoses are subjected to a test of one-and-a-half times the customer's stated working pressure, provided that this does not exceed the stated maximum test pressure. If a working pressure is not stated, then ARTIFEX Standard Test Procedures will apply.

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HOSE & BRAID MATERIALS

B-Flex & C-Flex hose is normally supplied in Stainless Steel Grade 321 S31. (Werkstoff Nr: 1.4541)
Braid is normally supplied in Grade 304L. (Werkstoff Nr: 1.4306)
All our hose and braid is also available in Grade 316L. (Werkstoff Nr: 1.4404)

MATERIALS TESTING

All hose assemblies are hydraulically tested before being despatched. Pneumatic testing by air or gas under water will be carried out where necessary.

CERTIFICATION

Test and material certificates will be supplied when specifically requested.

HOSE END FITTINGS

A comprehensive range of flanges, screwed connectors, tube ends or individually designed fittings can be welded to the hose by an Argon arc process. For details of standard fittings see pages 4 to 9 in the Artifex catalogue.

NB: Hose and Braid only, can be supplied to customers having the necessary equipment to manufacture their own hose assemblies.

MINIMUM BEND RADII

Dimensions given are for flexing applications. For static conditions 60% of this value should be used.
